### \$1/Week - Equivalent to a Lottery Ticket

- Pain management for one Hospice patient for two weeks
- Provides a seven year old a session of swim lessons through the YMCA's Swim Free Program
- One hour of counseling support and education to individuals with hearing or visual impairments through AURORA of CNY
- A girl can join Girl Scouts and receive all the essentials (journey book, insignia, and uniform)
- Three life jackets for children with disabilities at Camp Columbus

### \$2/Week - Equivalent to a Latte

- Kindergarten preparation via activities that foster reading, socialization, and motor skills for a month
- One week of food for 19 individuals at Chapel House Homeless Shelter
- Two elementary students can receive CHAD's Substance Abuse Prevention Program in school
- Oxygen for a Hospice patient for one month
- Two runaway/homeless youth with interventions, safety plans, and reunification with family through Cayuga Counseling Services

### \$5/Week - Equivalent to a Fast Food Breakfast

- Weekly counseling sessions for a year at the CHAD's Substance Abuse clinic
- Provides 44 round trips per year for a senior or disabled individual via SCAT VAN
- Four weeks with a one-on-one summer camp coach for a child with Autism
- A year's worth of nutritious snacks for 60 students enrolled in Booker T. Washington Community Center's after school program.
- Constructive learning, physical and social activities in the Y's afterschool program for a month

### \$10/Week - Equivalent to Lunch at Your Favorite Restaurant

- Three months of after-care case management for one individual to assist them with transitioning from homelessness to housing
- 10 girls can join Girl Scouts and receive all the essentials (journey book, insignia, and uniform)
- Pantry supplies for three families of three for one year
- Pain management to a Hospice patient for a month
- Sends two children to a week long camp experience for character building, friendships, and fun outdoors
