How Your Pledge Helps Children and Adults in OUR Community

\$1/Week - Equivalent to a Lottery Ticket

- Provides a seven year old a session of swim lessons through the YMCA's Swim Free Program
- Coordination, intervention, and advocacy services for a homeless youth for reunification
- A girl can join Girl Scouts and receive all the essentials (journey book, insignia, and uniform)
- Provides milk for each camper for a full week at Camp Columbus
- Ensures a child under five to receive a book each month for a year and a half

\$2/Week - Equivalent to a Latte

- Kindergarten preparation via activities that foster reading, socialization, and motor skills for a month
- One week of food for 19 individuals at Chapel House Homeless Shelter
- Provides aids and devices to low income individuals who are visually impaired or blind
- Clothing for 3 victims of sexual assault to wear home from the hospital after being treated
- Provides supplies for a classroom of 20 students in BTW's After School Program for one year

\$5/Week - Equivalent to a Fast Food Breakfast

- Provides gas to transport students from their schools to the After School Program for two months
- Pays for 7 hours of advocacy and case management for people who are deaf in our community
- Constructive learning, physical and social activities in the Y's afterschool program for a month
- Two week supply of hygiene items for Auburn Rescue Mission's families in their 28 unit facility
- Pays copayment for 6 months of therapy at the outpatient mental health clinic for someone struggling

\$10/Week - Equivalent to Lunch at Your Favorite Restaurant

- Provides 6 hours of sign language interpreting in the community
- Sends a Scout to a weeklong resident camp through the Long House Council, BSA
- Pantry supplies for three families of three for one year
- Sends two children to a week long camp experience for character building, friendships, and fun outdoors
- Provides a nutritious dinner for 60 students in the After School Program for two months
