PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT: AUBURN YMCA-WEIU

Gifts to the United Way of Cayuga County support **education**, **health**, **financial stability**, and **safety net** programs. Of your funded Member Agencies, the Auburn YMCA-WEIU receives funding for four programs. One of those programs is **School Age Childcare**. Last year, more than 20 Weedsport youth received after school care through this program. This year, the program has returned to Weedsport and was introduced to both Cato-Meridian Central School District and Port Byron Central School District!

Dear Neighbor:

As residents from the towns of Brutus and Conquest, we are excited to lead the United Way of Cayuga County Campaign for our neighbors in County North again this year. Giving back to our community and lending a hand to our neighbors is a part of who we are. Last year, with the help of more than 550 volunteers we raised enough funds to support 25 nonprofit agencies.

From gifts last year, our United Way of Cayuga is funding 34 programs addressing **education**, **health**, **financial stability**, and **safety net needs**. To ensure critical programs continue to support our neighbors, we are asking you to consider making a gift this campaign season.

With so many funded Member Agencies headquartered in the city of Auburn, it is hard to imagine that 29 of the 34 programs have the capacity to be countywide organizations based on who is accessing the program.

Did you know that Catholic Charities of the Finger Lakes' **Emergency Energy Assistance** program kept utilities on for six Port Byron neighbors last year? Or that the Auburn YMCA-WEIU provides **School Age Child Care** in the afternoons at Weedsport Elementary School? Ten of our neighbors turned to Cayuga Counseling Services' **SAVAR** (Sexual Assault Victim Advocacy Resource) program from the town of Sterling and village of Fair Haven when they needed a safe haven. Transportation Project of Cayuga County, better known as **SCAT Van**, has a van based out of Cato and provided rides to 547 County North neighbors.



Of Cayuga County neighbors enrolled in Aurora of CNY's Social Work Services for those with Sensory Loss last year, 21% live in County North between Weedsport, Sterling, Cato, and Port Byron. In addition to supporting nonprofit organizations who provide programs and services to Cayuga County residents, your United Way does so much more for our community.

The United Way of Cayuga County has a Community Building Mini-Grant Program to support 501©3 organizations with unexpected opportunities, existing programs, and professional development. During the last funding cycle, twelve grants went out to nonprofits, including the Weedsport Association for Parents & Teachers to support **teacher-led activities** during Weedsport Elementary School's annual Play Day for more than 300 students.
