41% of Cayuga County Residents are Impacted by United Way Funding | 2020

\$1 a Week -or- \$52 a Year

- Provides 17 rides for elderly and disabled residents throughout all of Cayuga County
- A day of emergency assistance including shelter, a cot, blankets, comfort kit, and 3 meals through the Red Cross
- Coordination, intervention, and advocacy services for a homeless youth
- Provides a lighted magnifier to a senior struggling with Age Related Macular Degeneration

\$2 a Week -or- \$104 a Year

- Provides an amplified telephone for a senior unable to hear friends and family over a traditional phone
- Clothing for 3 victims of sexual assault to wear home from the hospital after being treated
- One week of food for 19 individuals at Chapel House Homeless Shelter
- For one year, provides supplies for a classroom of 20 students in BTW's After School Program

\$5 a Week -or- \$260 a Year

- Two week supply of hygiene items for Auburn Rescue Mission's families in their 28 unit facility
- Pays co-payment for 6 months of therapy at an outpatient mental health clinic
- Pays for 7 hours of case management and advocacy for individuals with hearing and/or hearing loss
- Pays for two full weeks of music camp during the summer through Perform 4 Purpose

\$10 a Week -or- \$520 a Year

- Provides a nutritious dinner for 60 students for 2 months in the After School Program
- Financial assistance for a family impacted by a local disaster to purchase food, lodging, clothes, and other critical needs.
- Provides 6 hours of sign language interpreting
- Annually, pays for 52 sessions in the outpatient substance misuse disorder program
